

## English

This term in English we will link our work to the topic 'Marvellous Me.' We will start by exploring different feelings using the story 'The Colour Monster' From this we will write our own poetry. We will then use some performance poetry connected to the skeleton. To finish the half term we will use our research skills to write non chronological about different parts of the body.

## Maths

This term we will focus on ensuring the children have a secure knowledge of numbers to 1000 in Year 3 and 10,000 in Year 4. We are following Whiterose in our sessions. This will include using lots of practical resources to help the children understand the different values. We will then work on our addition and subtraction skills. We will use Times Table Rockstars and 99 club for our weekly tables. We will let you know more about this at a later date.

## Science (Animals including humans)

We will focus on the human body, naming some of the bones in a human and animal skeleton and looking at how muscles work. We will move onto the digestive system and teeth. We will look at the different types of teeth and the journey of food through the body.

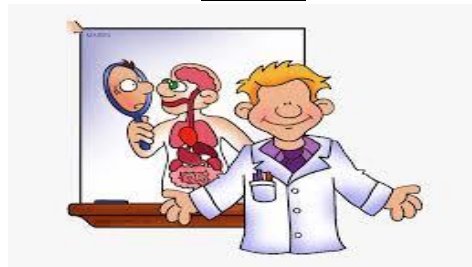
## French
