WHATSAPP GROUPS

Although these groups are in no way affiliated with St Mary's, may I suggest that 'Group Admins' look to establish a Code of Conduct to ensure that these continue to be supportive and positive for all. Here is a possible example:

- * The group should not be used as a platform to air views/grievances regarding the school, a teacher, child or parent.*
- * The group should not be used to discuss incidents which have happened during the school day.
- * At all times, group members must be culturally sensitive and maintain a high level of mutual respect between all its members.
